PowerLunch Facts

What is PowerLunch?

Power Lunch is an automated point of sales system for purchasing lunch. It allows parents to deposit money into a student account.

How do students deposit money into there account?

Students will bring their check or cash to the cafeteria each morning for deposit.

Student I.D. cards.

Students will be issued a picture I. D. card that will remain at school. The students scan the cards each time they purchase lunch.

Online Access to account balance and activity.

Each student has been issued a PowerLunch I. D. number. Parents can access our PowerLunch feature by going to www.woodstown.org and selecting our PowerSchool link and then the balance \$ icon. This will allow you to review all activity for the day. If you have any difficulty accessing this feature, please contact our PowerSchool coordinator, Mrs. Stacy Carney-Shorter.
